DELTA DRONE has been chosen by Eurovia, subsidiary of VINCI, a world leader in transport-infrastructure construction and urban development, and one of the main producers of aggregates in Europe, to offer its solutions for data collection using drones in its 240 Eurovia quarries located in France.

Data collection via the acquisition of images by drones, in a few hours and in complete safety, and then the processing of such data, allows for the creation of a complete digital terrain model (DTM) of a site in order, for example, to calculate the cubic volume of materials, update the profile of a quarry's faces or simulate the extraction phasing.

This success in one of the five target verticals identified by the DELTA DRONE Group marks the fruition of efforts made over several years to perfect professional solutions adapted to its clients' needs. Three years after the first assignments carried out for VICAT, which remains a preferred client of the Group, this second reference strengthens DELTA DRONE's presence in a key sector of its development strategy.

This progress in the quarrying sector is especially significant in that it goes hand in hand with the leading position the Group holds in the mining sector thanks to its South-African subsidiary, ROCKETMINE.
